- Beef Skillathon will be divided into three age divisions: Junior, Intermediate and Senior
- The Beef Skillathon will be composed of a beef cattle/livestock quiz portion and <u>five</u> individual stations pertaining to different agricultural industry sectors. This will allow juniors to learn skills, facts, and indepth knowledge of both the beef cattle and agriculture industry. The scores of both the quiz portion and the five individual stations will be added together to determine the placings. Competitors will need to complete both portions (quiz and all five stations) to increase their overall score.
- Competitors will individually take both the quiz and answer the questions of the Beef Skillathon by themselves. Competitors will be assigned into groups and rotated around to the individual stations to complete this portion of the Beef Skillathon.
