

## Junior Beefmaster Breeders Association (JBBA)

2019 Scholarship Application



The JBBA scholarship program is sponsored by JBBA to encourage junior members to continue their higher education beyond the high school level as well as to provide financial assistance for pursuing their further education.

Each JBBA scholarship will be in the amount of \$500, payable upon proof of admittance and enrollment in classes at a University or Junior College. \*See requirements below\* The number of JBBA scholarships may vary from year to year.

Candidate(s) for the JBBA scholarship(s) must be a <u>current member</u> of the Junior Beefmaster Breeders Association (JBBA). Applicant must be a minimum of a high school graduate the year of the application.

#### **Application must include three (3) recommendation letters** from the following:

- 1) Beefmaster Breeder (other than a member of your immediate family)
- 2) County Agent, FFA Advisor, or 4-H Club Adult Leader, and
- 3) School Principal, School Counselor, Teacher, College Advisor or College Professor.

**Applications will** <u>only</u> be accepted if they are complete. Please make certain ALL questions are answered to the best of your ability. Applicants may be interviewed by scholarship committee by either a phone interview or interviewed during the 2019 National Convention. Scholarship winners will be announced at the 2019 JBBA National Convention and Shows awards banquets.

Applications are due in the BBU office by or before June 21, 2019. Applications will <u>not</u> be accepted after the deadline.

#### To obtain payment of scholarship, JBBA member must:

- Forward proof of enrollment to the JBBA office no later than October 1 of the year in which they are named the recipient, or the scholarship will be forfeited.
- Must include an official current transcript
- Send a **thank you note** to JBBA (electronic "thank you" *NOT* accepted)
- Send address where to mail scholarship check
