2020 ASSOCIATE DELEGATION LEADERS

Fort Worth Sister Cities alums, university students, and young professionals interested in assisting as Associate Delegation Leaders (ADL) on Fort Worth's international youth exchanges in the spring and summer of 2020 are invited to apply now. Applicants should have a strong interest in global awareness and a desire to share that passion with youth. Up to two ADLs per exchange will be invited to assist leaders and are expected to assist in orientations and on the actual trip. This program allows you to share your knowledge and leadership skills while exploring the diverse culture of the sister city visited. Exchanges include recognition by the mayor and city officials in Fort Worth and the city visited.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Work closely with Delegation Leader (DL) to supervise 10-20 students in grades 8-12 during an international educational and cultural visit to one of Fort Worth's sister cities.
- Work with DL to coordinate and implement monthly student orientations prior to the trip.
- Serve as a positive role model to the participating Youth Ambassadors.
- Attend 3-4 orientations prior to departure (alums of Sister Cities programs who attend universities outside of Fort Worth are encouraged to apply and can attend orientations via Skype).
- Attend a pre-travel orientation Sunday, Dec. 1, 2019.
- Work with the DL to provide an educational, fun, and successful trip for the students.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: OCT. 18, 2019

Interviews will be scheduled by the delegation leader. Incomplete applications will not be considered. If selected, applicants will be asked to attend a mandatory delegation and associate delegation leader orientation.

COST

- A \$500 non-refundable deposit is due Nov. 29, 2019. Final balance is due 45 days prior to departure.
- All trip costs include round-trip airfare, taxes, ground transportation, lodging, insurance, tours, day trips, and most meals.
- A scholarship of \$350 has been allocated for each ADL selected and has already been applied to trip costs.
- Estimated costs may be adjusted if you utilize your own miles/rewards or book your own flights.

REGGIO EMILIA, ITALY: March 7-15, 2020
