PULL THE PLUG ON MINISTELS

CLEAN, DRAIN & DRY YOUR WATERCRAFT, IT'S THE LAW.

When leaving a listed aquatic invasive species (AIS) water or lake in Arizona such as Lake Powell, Mead, Mohave, Havasu, Pleasant, Apache, Canyon, or Saguaro, you must inspect, clean, drain and dry your boat.





FOLLOW THESE SIMPLE STEPS



CLEAN

Remove mud, plants and animals from every part of your boat, trailer, anchor, lines and equipment. If it gets wet, it could harbor mussels.



DRAIN

Pull your drain plug every time you take your watercraft out of the water. Before you leave the recreation area, eliminate ALL water from your boat, including livewells, ballast and engine-cooling water.



DRY

Allow time for your boat to completely dry before launching in other waters. Allow boat to dry for at least 5 days before entering another waterbody.
